

This award recognizes outstanding service by club members. It was named for Tom Botts, who until his death at age 94 on March 1, 1999, was the club's oldest member. Affectionately called "Coach" because of his tenure as MU track coach from 1946 to 1972, Tom served as Club Secretary for 13 years during the 1970s and 1980s. In recognition of his many years of outstanding service to the club, the community, and the University, he was given a special award by the Board of Directors in 1985, and the **Tom Botts Award** was created.
